

## Firearm Safety Course

**Date:** Saturday, July 31

**Time:** 8 am – 5 pm

**Fee:** \$65

**Location:** Rm 74, Iowa Lakes Community College, 300 South 18<sup>th</sup> Street, Estherville (use main entrance #1 on west side of building, go straight through the lobby towards the cafeteria, Room 74 is on the right before you get to the Cafeteria.

**Instructors:** Assistant Chief Jason Petersen of the Okoboji Police Department and Lieutenant Tony Petersen of the Dickinson County Sheriff's Office, both certified by the NRA and ILEA as firearms instructors.

The **Firearm Safety Course** is required for anyone who wishes to obtain a concealed weapons permit in Iowa. Effective July 1, 2007, Iowa Administrative Code requires anyone who attends the **Firearm Safety Course** to fulfill a range requirement during the course of training. The **Firearm Safety Course** consists of classroom education and actual live fire with a handgun. Students must be at least 18 years of age to attend.

### The course will cover:

- Federal Law
- Iowa Law
- Legal and Ethical Use of a Firearm
- Firearms Safety
- Principles of Marksmanship
- Practical Range Exercise

### Students are required to bring the following items to class:

- Form WPO – authorization from your county sheriff approving you to participate in this course.
- Quality handgun (revolver or semi-auto) no larger than .44 Remington Magnum.
- 50 rounds of ammunition, only new factory or factory-remanufactured ammunition will be allowed (no hand reloads will be permitted). **Be certain the ammunition is correct for your caliber handgun.**
- Holster designed for your handgun.
- Proper eye (safety glasses or goggles) and hearing protection (ear plugs or muffs).
- Attendees must be thoroughly familiar with their handgun. There will be no time allotted for one-on-one training.

### Notes:

- All handguns will be inspected by the instructors for proper function and operational safety prior to the range exercise.
- Do **NOT** bring your handgun to the classroom with you. You will be given ample time to retrieve your firearm for the range exercise.
- While driving to the course be sure your handgun is unloaded, cased and in the rear most portion of your vehicle.

**NOTE:** You must register directly with Iowa Lakes Community College. Receiving approval from your County Sheriff does **not** automatically register you in the course. Seats usually fill fast, so contact the college to register early -- you must call the college to reserve your seat.
